

NO-SEW SIMPLE UTHANDO DOLLS' CLOTHING

The success of these patterns often depends on using knit fabric or fabric which doesn't fray. This means no need for hems or facings. Some require a few stitches.



CIRCLE SKIRT: Choose the length of the skirt as the radius to suit your doll. Cut out a circle. A plate can be the template. Fold material into quarters and trim. Then cut out a **very** small quarter circle in the point of the four folds. It will stretch to fit the waist of the doll.

Ideal to add as an item in the shoulder bag. Add trim.

NO-SEW JACKET: Choose non-fray fabric. Make the space between the armholes wide enough for your doll's back. Cut the outside shape according to your imagination. Can be short or long. Add button or tie.





FLIP-OVER TOP

is held on by a cord, ribbon or length of stretch fabric, easily tied around the doll. There are a thousand ways to make it a delight to play with. Think pockets, different neck shape, different 'sleeves', or none. Long or short, wide or narrow.

Do attach the tie so that it doesn't get lost. Remember to cut out with the fold on top.



ONE SHOULDER TIE DRESS

requires only a few oversews for strength, then approx. 8 running stitches (not oversew) on the wrong side when you join the one side seam. Finish with a strong oversew before you get to the hem, so it is easier for dressing and won't rip open.

Cut with the fold down one side. Make the extensions for the ties comfortably long when you cut along the fold to make armholes from the same height as the other side.



VEST WITH SHOULDER SEAMS

is made from one piece of fabric. The sketch pattern is on the side of the Classic Sewn Doll pattern. Fold on the centre back, cut out armholes and shape the front. Stitch the small shoulder seams firmly. Can take a button. Looks great in faux fur, but can be any non fray fabric.
