## CROCHETED DOLL PATTERN

Materials: 8 ply knitting yarn - Main Colour (MC)(brown for skin) Contrasting Colours (C1 C2) No 3.50 crochet hook. Note Adjust the size of hook if using different ply yarn.

Abbreviations: ch - chain, d c - double crochet, (if used to American terms, sc - single crochet) SI st - slip stitch, inc - increase, foll - following, rep - repeat, dec - decrease, w/o - without.

Head: Make three ch, join into a ring.
$1^{\text {st }}$ round: 6 dc into ring.
$2^{\text {nd }}$ round; 2 dc into each dc (12dc)
$3^{\text {rd }}$ round As $2^{\text {nd }}$ round ( 24 d c )
$4^{\text {th }}$ round Work 1 round w/o increasing
$5^{\text {th }}$ round: Inc in every $4^{\text {th }}$ stitch ( 30 d c )
$6^{\text {th }}$ round: Inc in every $5^{\text {th }}$ stitch ( 36 d c )
$7^{\text {th }}$ round: Inc in every $6^{\text {th }}$ stitch ( 42 d c )
Work four rounds without inc.
Turn. Wind wool around first finger of left hand 3 times, insert hook through next st and through 3 loops on finger, draw through stitch, wool round hook and draw through all loops on hook. Release loops from finger and repeat in next 22 stitches
 (this forms loops for hair)
Turn, d c to end of round (end of round should be where loops began.)
Miss every $6^{\text {th }} \mathrm{d} \mathrm{c}$ in next and following rounds until 24 sts remain.
Stuff head firmly and then miss every $4^{\text {th }}$ st until 10 sts remain. Draw together with needle and fasten off. Add features (embroider/felt etc). Make black iris larger than illustrated here.

## Legs (make 2)

Begin at foot.
Make three ch into a ring
$1^{\text {st }}$ round: 6 dc into ring
$2^{\text {nd }}$ round: 2 dc into each $\mathrm{dc}(12 \mathrm{st}$ )
$3^{\text {rd }}$ round: dc in first st, inc. in second st repeat to end ( 18 dc )
Work 4 more rounds w/o increasing
Change to C 1 for $8^{\text {th }}$ round and continue straight of 11 more rounds.
Finish off

## Body

Join C1 to leg
$1^{\text {st }}$ round: 1 dc into next 15 dc , working along top of
$1^{\text {st }} \mathrm{leg}$, miss $3 \mathrm{dc}, 1 \mathrm{dc}$ into next 15 dc of $2^{\text {nd }}$ leg.
$2^{\text {nd }}$ round: 1 dc into each $\mathrm{dc}(30 \mathrm{dc}$ )
Continue in dc for 5 rounds
Change to C2 and d c 12 more rounds.
Finish off.
Arms (make 2)
As for legs Round one and two.
$3^{\text {rd }}$ round: inc twice evenly ( 14 d c )
$4^{\text {th }}$ and $5^{\text {th }}$ round $\mathrm{d} \mathrm{c} \mathrm{w} / \mathrm{o}$ increasing
$6^{\text {th }}$ round change to C 2 and make 11 rounds
Finish off
Crochet or stitch to join inside legs. Stuff legs \& body \& stitch top opening together
Stitch on arms and head.
*Vary amount of MC in legs and arms to make shorts and to shorten length of shirt sleeves.
Complete whole doll in skin colour. Stitch or crochet clothes.
